Mayor Elsa Noguera welcomed 11 new English-speaking World Teach foundation volunteers, to be included in the program 'Barranquilla Bilingual: English and Competitiveness Opportunities' program, which seeks to improve the quality of English teaching in the District, as a strategy for language development of students.

The program implemented by World Teach, through Colombia Volunteers Foundation, is based on the coteaching methodology which seeks teachers and volunteers support each other in all matters relating to the teaching of English, while to exchange cultural aspects and skills of each are strengthened.

"The bilingual program in Barranquilla is a reality. Currently 67% of our district teachers are in category Very Superior B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference, in management of a second language, a breakthrough because when we started it was only 8%, "noted Mayor Elsa Noguera during welcoming ceremony at FDI Hilda Muñoz.

The president added: "Thanks to the volunteers for the beautiful work you are doing for our children and young people have a better future."

"The important thing is that students have fun while learning English," said Frank Hand, World Teach volunteer at FDI Jorge N. Abello, who demonstrated interactive learning through music with his students.
